Dear Mr. Kersman:

As a follow up to our meeting here at NSF of December 18, 2006 on the NSF acceptance of anodized aluminum I wanted to confirm our conversation.

NSF accepts anodized aluminum manufactured using the sulfuric acid process. The chromic acid process is not acceptable. If for use in direct contact with food, any dyes would also require a toxicological review prior to acceptance.
